PART-TIME JOB OPENING IN AQUATICS: LOCKER ROOM

The City of South San Francisco's Aquatics Division is looking for Part-Time Locker Room Attendants for its aquatic facility. Under the direct supervision of the Recreation Supervisor or Instructor-in-Charge, the Locker Attendant shall be responsible for the cleanliness of the locker room and shower area; and assist patrons in the proper procedure for checking their clothing and valuables.

Distinguishing Characteristics:

The Locker Attendant is responsible for attentively monitoring the locker room area in order to prevent accidents and maintains order; personally keeps the locker room, showers, restrooms, and pool area in a clean and sanitary condition; and assists patrons in the proper procedure for checking their clothing and valuables to prevent theft.

Important and Essential Duties:

Prevents accidents through enforcement of policies, rules, and ordinances governing the conduct of persons at a swimming pool.
Maintains constant supervision of the locker room area.
Maintains the locker room, restrooms, showers, and pool area in a clean and sanitary condition.
Checks all swimmers for swim attire and cleanliness.
Reports any repairs needed in the locker room.
Follow prescribed procedures in cases of emergency.
Maintain good public relations.
Attend meetings and training as required.
Perform other related duties as required.

Job Related and Essential Qualifications

Knowledge of:

Skills and techniques needed to perform general cleaning.

Ability to:

Follow written and oral instructions.
Use standard janitorial equipment.
Deal effectively with staff and pool patrons.
Deal with stressful situations

Education Experience

Must be 15 years of age or older

Licenses, Certificates and Other Requirements

Certification in First Aid and CPR as issued by the American Red Cross or approved equivalent is desirable.

Any offer of employment to an adult employee who will have direct contact with minors is conditional upon submission of a completed fingerprint card and a satisfactory background check.

Special Requirements

Essential duties require the following physical skills and work environment: Lift and carry objects up to 25 pounds; work in typical swimming pool environment; use standard janitorial equipment; vision to spot those needing assistance in the locker room, and to enforce pool rules and regulations; hearing and speech to communicate with patrons and staff.
