## City of South San Francisco Seeking Members to Serve on the Measure W Citizens' Oversight Committee

*Applications due this Friday, August 26th*



South San Francisco voters approved [Measure W](#), a half-cent transactions and use tax in November 2015. As part of the Measure W implementation process, the City is seeking members to serve on the Measure W Citizens' Oversight Committee.

The Oversight Committee shall report periodically to the City Council regarding the collection and expenditure of Measure W funds.

- The Measure W Oversight Committee will consist of five members

appointed by the City Council.

- o Three members shall serve an initial term of four years.
- o Two members shall serve an initial term of three years.

At the conclusion of the initial terms, all members will serve four year terms. Any South San Francisco resident or representative of a business located in South San Francisco, who is 18 years of age or older, is eligible to be appointed to the Oversight Committee. The City Council may give preference to applicants with financial management experience.




