San Mateo County residents can make an appointment to dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) for free at the next special collection event in South San Francisco on **Saturday, December 3 2016** from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

To participate, you must schedule an appointment at San Mateo County's HHW Program: www.smchealth.org/hhw or by calling (650) 363-4718, select option 3. The event location will be disclosed once your appointment has been confirmed. No commercial waste is allowed. Limit 10 gallons.
