City offices and programs will be closed the afternoon of Friday, December 23rd and all day Monday, December 26th. In addition, the afternoon of Friday, Dec. 30 and all day Monday, January 2 in observance of the New Year's holiday.

El Camino Real Speed Limit Change in South San Francisco

Change expected to occur mid-late December



In an effort to improve safety along the El Camino Real corridor in South San Francisco, Caltrans is changing the speed limit from 40 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour.

A traffic study was conducted in the fall and after evaluating the vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian activities, and the complete street features with various enhancements, it was recommended the speed limit be lowered to better fit the developments along this segment of the El Camino Real corridor.
