The One Day Homeless Count is a census and survey of unsheltered people conducted in collaboration with community and County partners. The results from the count will provide the County with a better understanding of the number of homeless individuals and families and their needs.

Volunteers Needed!

Sign up today as a team member to assist in tallying and administering surveys to homeless individuals in a particular coverage area throughout the County.

All volunteers will also need to sign up for a 2-hour mandatory training in the weeks leading up to the One Day Homeless Count. All volunteers need to be at least 18 years old.
