San Mateo County residents can make an appointment to dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) for free at the next

special collection event in South San Francisco on Saturday, **February 4, 2017 from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**

To participate, **you must schedule an appointment** at San Mateo County's HHW Program: www.smchealth.org/hhw or by calling (650) 363-4718, select option 3. The event location will be disclosed once your appointment has been confirmed. No commercial waste is allowed. Limit 10 gallons.

Residents unable to attend this event can still dispose of HHW for free at San Mateo County's permanent HHW facility Thursdays through Saturdays (except major holiday weekends). You must make an appointment at the above noted website and phone number.

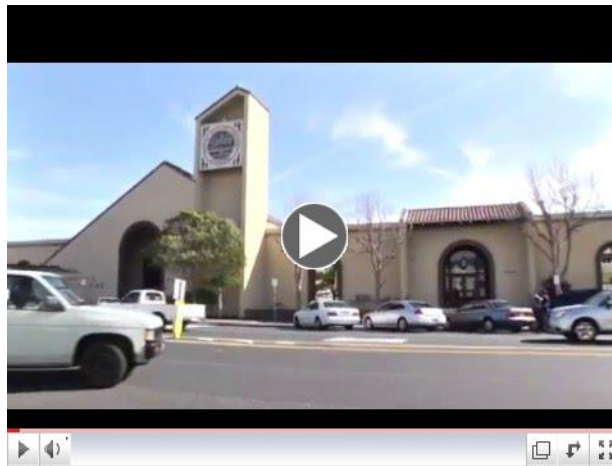
