Property Tax Deferments Available



If you are having difficulty with property tax payments on your home, there are options that may help you weather current challenges. The State Controller's [Property Tax Postponement Program](#) has resumed after being suspended by the Legislature in 2009. Funding is limited and is available on a first-come-first-serve basis.

The program allows homeowners who are at least 62 years old, are blind, or have a disability to defer current-year property taxes on their principal residence if they meet certain criteria, including 40 percent equity in the home and an annual household income of \$35,500 or less.
