struggle at school. They want to learn, but it's tough when their stomachs are growling and they can't concentrate.

### What to donate?

Meals in a can (soup, stew, chili)

Low-sodium canned vegetables  
Olive or canola oil  
Spices  
Low-sugar whole grain cereals  
Healthy snacks (granola bars, nuts, dried fruit)
