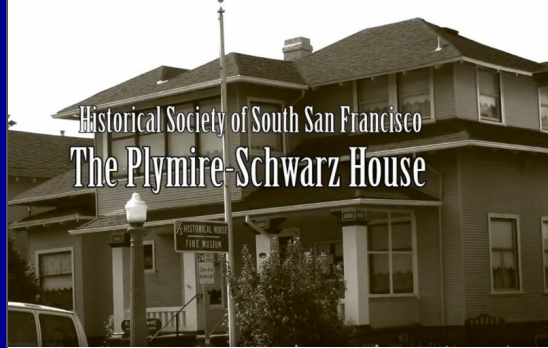

## SamTrans Summer Youth Pass

*Good for unlimited rides from June 1 through August 31*



It's that time of year for parents to purchase a Summer Youth Pass (SYP) for kids 18 and younger. The SYP is available for \$40 and is good for unlimited rides on SamTrans from June 1 through August 31, and parents save \$41 compared to buying three Youth Monthly passes.

Kids can find their way to the museums, libraries, movie theaters, shopping and entertainment by riding SamTrans throughout San Mateo County and the Coastsides.

The SYP can be purchased by going to [SamTrans.com/SYP](http://SamTrans.com/SYP) or by visiting the SamTrans headquarters at 1250 San Carlos Ave. in San Carlos, which is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The SYP will not be available on the Clipper card.
