CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN SSF

428 BADEN AVENUE

The sidewalk along the project's Baden Avenue frontage is closed. The sidewalk will be reopened in a subsequent phase of work. Pedestrian detour signage is deployed, noting a safe path of travel around the work area. Additionally, the project expects daily material deliveries, and additional truck traffic is expected. The contractor will maintain vehicular access to Baden Avenue and 3rd Lane. Drivers can expect minor delays. Construction flaggers will be deployed during material deliveries. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



CALTRANS SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 82 (El Camino Real)

Caltrans is continuing a safety enhancement project in the city along State Route 82 (El Camino Real) between September 2023 and February 2024 (weather dependent). The project includes installing accessible pedestrian signals and countdown pedestrian signals at various locations. Work also includes painting red curbs from crosswalks to enhance safety for pedestrian's cyclist. Adding the red curbs is expected to enhance the sight lines between a pedestrian waiting to cross at the crosswalk and approaching traffic. Because of the safety enhancements, some parking spots are being removed.

Project will be impacting two locations in South San Francisco at Country Club Drive and Ponderosa Drive.

EI CAMINO REAL (Between Arroyo Dr. and Kaiser Way)

Improvements continue along El Camino Real between Arroyo Drive and Kaiser Way as part of the Grand Boulevard project which includes improvements to sidewalks, planting, roadway, lighting, and landscaping. Work is currently focused along the median of El Camino Real and Del Paso Drive. Minor lane shifts will be deployed as work is underway along El Camino Real. Pedestrian detour signage when required will be deployed, noting a safe path of travel around the work area. Drivers can expect minor delays. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



IMPROVEMENT

Streetscape improvement work at the intersection of Grand Avenue and Airport Boulevard continues. The work will improve all four corners of the intersection, including the medians. The work is being phased to minimize impacts, but due to the nature of the work, traffic control measures will remain up 24/7, with work proceeding daily, Monday through Friday, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

The current work is scheduled on the median at Airport Blvd between Grand Avenue and Baden Avenue. The work will result in single-lane closures impacting northbound & southbound travel along Airport Boulevard. Delays are expected during working hours.

The left turn lane northbound Airport Boulevard at Grand Avenue will be eliminated to improve intersection efficiency and reduce conflicts between vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians. Please use the alternate left turns along Airport Boulevard at Baden Avenue and Miller Avenue.

Commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes. Construction flaggers will be deployed to help maintain vehicular travel when necessary. Pedestrian detour signage will be deployed, routing pedestrians around the work zones. Pedestrian access to Caltrain Station is maintained. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



KILROY OYSTER POINT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT (379 Oyster Point Blvd)

Contractor will be performing work that will impact Oyster Point Boulevard east of Gull Drive and the Marina. Work will result in lane shifts for a 24-hour period impacting both eastbound and westbound travel along Oyster Point Boulevard around the Marina between Monday, October 30 and Wednesday, November 1. Delays are expected and commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



PG&E SUBSTATION (Gateway Blvd between E. Grand Ave and Oyster Point Blvd)

Work continues along Gateway Boulevard between E. Grand Avenue and Oyster Point Boulevard. Work will result in a 24/7 lane closure on northbound Gateway Boulevard and eastbound Oyster Point Boulevard just past Gateway Boulevard. Work is being phased to minimize impacts to travel. The work will proceed between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. daily. Travel through Gateway Boulevard will be maintained, but commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes as there may be momentary delays. Construction flaggers will be deployed to help keep vehicular travel when necessary. The sidewalks will remain open as work is underway.



SMART CORRIDORS EXPANSION PROJECT

The Smart Corridor Expansion project is a joint effort by the City and Caltrans to develop a traffic management system along key arterial corridors that parallel US-101 and I-380. The Smart Corridor program provides public agencies the tools to safely manage traffic congestion through local streets during normal operating conditions, major freeway incidents, and special events.

The project stretches along the following:

1. Airport Blvd: US-101 (City limit) to Terminal Ct.
2. South Airport Blvd: Road 21 to Mitchell Ave.
3. Gateway Blvd: Mitchell Ave to Oyster Point Blvd.

Work will proceed daily (Monday through Friday). Some work will be performed at night to alleviate possible congestion resulting from this work.

Week of November 6 (Work hours 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.):

- Southbound Airport Blvd. at Tower Pl.
- Airport Blvd and Butler Ave.
- Northbound S. Airport Blvd at Wondercolor Ln.
- Northbound Gateway Blvd between E. Grand Ave and Mitchell Ave.
- Gateway Blvd and Oyster Point Blvd.
- Airport Blvd and Miller Ave.

Week of November 13 (Work hours 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.):

- Southbound Airport Blvd. from Pine Ave to Lux Ave.
- Gateway Blvd and Oyster Point Blvd.
- Airport Blvd and Miller Ave.
- Northbound S. Airport Blvd at Wondercolor Ln (only on 11/17/23).

Commuters can expect delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes.



SSF QUICK STRIKE BUS STOP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (Multiple Locations)

The Quick-Strike Bus Stop Improvement project will install new bus stops throughout East of US-101. Work will necessitate temporary shoulder/lane closures and will impact sidewalk as work is underway. Work will proceed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Upcoming work is scheduled at the following bus stop locations:

1. Haskins Way/Swift Ave and E. Grand Ave/Haskins Way.
2. Gateway Blvd between E. Grand Ave and Oyster Point Blvd (total of 3 bus stops).

Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



2023 STREET SURFACE PROJECT

City is gearing up to begin its 2023 street improvement project along various streets west of US-101 (see map below). Work will be phased to minimize impacts from construction. The first phase of work will begin on Monday, October 2 and will proceed daily between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Within the first phase the following will be completed:

- Repair of failed concrete curb & gutter sections.

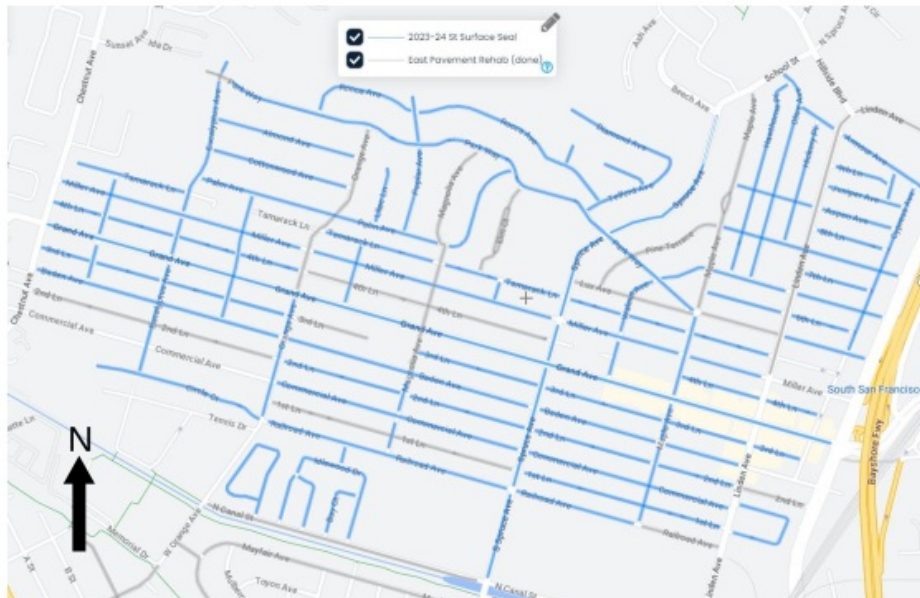
- Repair of failed valley gutter sections.
- Repair of failed sections in the asphalt pavement.

The work described above is scheduled at the following street segments for the Week of 11/06 – 11/10/2023:

- Maple Ave between Lux Ave and Railroad Ave.
- Miller Ave between Chestnut Ave and Linden Ave.
- Railroad Ave between Orange Ave to Maple Ave.
- Pine Ave between Linden Ave and Airport Ave.

Notice will be posted along impacted areas 72-hours in advance of impact. Local access will be maintained throughout most phases of work. Delays are expected and commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.

30 TANFORAN AVENUE - SOUTHLINE DEVELOPMENT

Utility work continues impacting multiple streets and serving as a frontage to the project. The work is being phased to minimize vehicle and pedestrian travel disruptions. The work will proceed as follows:

- **Dollar Avenue** between Tanforan Avenue and S. Linden Avenue parking will be restricted during working hours to allow temporary lane shifts to occur between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Lane shifts will impact both the northbound and southbound travel on Dollar Avenue.

Commuters can expect delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes. Construction flaggers will be deployed to help maintain vehicular travel. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



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
