Coming Soon - Citizen's Academy 2023

South San Francisco offers a free Citizen's Academy every other year, designed to provide a hands-on overview of City government. The Academy will run for 9 consecutive Tuesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m., beginning

September 12 and running through November 14. The program provides an opportunity for residents to learn how and why City decisions are made and how City funds are allocated. Each week, a different department, including the City Council and City Attorney, will host a session, provide an informative presentation that highlights their department (including staffing, budget, operations, etc.). A light catered dinner for participants and staff is included. Sessions are held at different locations. Many Citizen's Academy graduates have gone on to serve on Boards and Commissions.
