Free Community College Program. The Free College Fee Waiver (SB 893) is an enrollment fee waiver that applies to students who reside in San Mateo County. Depending on financial need students may also be exempted from paying the student body fee, student representation fee, student union fee, inclusive access fee(s), and materials fees associated with the course. Check the FAQ to determine how you qualify.

No application is needed, and fee waivers are applied automatically to qualifying students upon registration. Please note that Free College may not cover all associated fees.
