Citizen's Academy 2023 – Accepting Applications Now!

South San Francisco offers a free Citizen's Academy, designed to provide a hands-on overview of City government. Community Input for San Mateo County Measure K: Listening Sessions & Survey

The County of San Mateo announced a series of listening sessions and survey to hear directly from residents about their experiences and needs on issues of housing and homelessness, children and families, emergency preparedness, and mental health. These four areas were identified as priorities for the Board of Supervisors and were also elevated in other community outreach efforts. Residents are invited to attend a listening session and take an online survey, which is available in English, Spanish, Tagalog and Simplified Chinese.

Your voice matters! We hope to hear from communities most impacted by inequities.

These listening sessions are designed to create a welcoming environment for everyone to share their unique perspective, including removing language barriers. Live interpretation and small group discussions will occur in English, Spanish, Cantonese, and Mandarin at each session and additionally in Tagalog in Daly City and San Mateo.

A listening session will be taking place on August 23, 2023 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Fernekes Building at Orange Memorial Park (781 Tennis Drive).

More than Just Meals

- Free annual bus passes;
- Lower Advanced Placement (AP) testing fees;
- Discounts of \$30 or \$75 per month on their internet bills; and
- \$100 discount to purchase a laptop, desktop computer or tablet.

Every meal application also translates to additional funding for our school district. Funding for:

- Technology in schools;
- After school programs;
- Counseling services; and
- Free school lunches.

What is a Quick-build?


