About the City's Below Market Rate Program

The City of South San Francisco's Below Market Rate (BMR) Program requires the sale of homes priced to be affordable to households that are low to moderate income. Usually, the BMR price is lower than the prices of similar homes that are being sold or rented on the open market. BMR owners must occupy the home as their primary residence and cannot rent the home. The Ordinance guiding this program, as well as the BMR rental program, is Chapter 20.380 of the City's Municipal Code. Proposed SamTrans fare changes

SamTrans is proposing some changes and improvements to its bus fares and would like to hear from you!

These changes are designed to simplify the fare structure, add new options and benefits for SamTrans riders, and in many cases reduce fares. Proposed changes to be implemented on January 1, 2024:

- Elimination of the Summer Youth Pass. Summer Youth Pass has had a steady decline in participation and was paused during the pandemic and 2023. The decline in participation was amplified by the introduction of the <u>SamTrans Youth Unlimited Pass</u> which provides free SamTrans ridership for qualifying low-income students.
- Consolidation of Local and Express fares for a single price. All prices will be local fares and all local fare rules will apply.
- Free fares for pre-arranged school field trips. San Mateo County public schools will be eligible for free SamTrans bus service for pre-arranged field trips.

Proposed changes to be implemented upon the launch of <u>Clipper[®] Next</u> <u>Generation</u> (estimated Fall 2024):

- Introduction of contactless Open Payment. Customers will be able to pay for fares using contactless credit and debit cards on Clipper validators on SamTrans bus service.
- Introduction of Day Pass and Monthly Pass Accumulators (also known as fare capping). Fares for customers using Clipper or open payments will be capped for daily and monthly usage.
- Discontinuation of bus fare payment on the SamTrans mobile app. Customers will be able to purchase tickets on the Clipper mobile app.
- Participation in the regional transfer discount program. Customers will get discounted fares for transferring between participating Bay Area transit systems.

SamTrans propone algunos cambios y mejoras a sus tarifas de autobús y nos gustaría conocer su opinión.

Estos cambios están diseñados con la propuesta de simplificar la estructura de tarifas, agregar nuevas opciones y beneficios para los pasajeros de SamTrans, y en muchos casos, reducir las tarifas.

Los cambios propuestos serán implementados el 1 de enero de 2024:

- Eliminación del pase "Summer Youth Pass". La participación del pase
 "Summer Youth Pass" ha disminuido constantemente y se interrumpió
 durante la pandemia y en 2023. Este resultado se vio por la
 implementación del pase SamTrans Youth Unlimited que ofrece
 transporte gratuito a los estudiantes de SamTrans con bajos ingresos
 que cumplan los requisitos.
- Consolidación de las tarifas locales y exprés por un precio único. Todos los precios serán tarifas locales y se aplicarán todas las normas tarifarias locales.
- Tarifas gratuitas para excursiones escolares organizadas con antelación. Las escuelas públicas del condado de San Mateo reunirán los requisitos para recibir el servicio gratuito de autobuses de SamTrans para excursiones organizadas con antelación.

Los cambios propuestos se aplicarán en el momento del lanzamiento de <u>Clipper[®] Next Generation</u> (previsto para otoño de 2024):

- Introducción del "Pago abierto" (Open Payment) sin contacto Los clientes podrán pagar sus tarifas utilizando tarjetas de crédito y débito sin contacto en los validadores Clipper del servicio de autobuses de SamTrans.
- Introducción de acumuladores del pase de un día y pase mensual (también conocidos como "Limitación de tarifas" (Fare Capping). Las tarifas de los clientes que utilicen Clipper o pago abierto tendrán un límite para el uso diario y mensual.
- Se suspende el pago del pasaje de autobús en la aplicación móvil de SamTrans. Los clientes podrán comprar los boletos en la aplicación móvil Clipper.
- Participación en el programa regional de descuentos por trasbordo. Los clientes obtendrán tarifas con descuento para realizar trasbordos entre los sistemas de transporte público participantes del Área de la Bahía.
