


# Mayor's Update


City of South San Francisco offices and facilities will be closed on Monday, January 15, in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.



#### **Affordable Connectivity Program**



The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers. This Covid-era program may be coming to a close, so apply soon if interested!

Student Aid & Cal. Dream Act Applications



The South San Francisco Unified School District is committed to having all of their 12th grade students complete either the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the California Dream Act Application (CADAA). In alignment with their *Drawing of a Graduate*, through this effort they are helping students LEARN, THRIVE, and NAVIGATE.

AB 469 requires all high school seniors to apply for financial aid. There are several changes to the financial aid application process this year, some of which expand aid eligibility and make it easier for families to apply, however, some of the changes compound barriers that make it challenging for historically marginalized families to complete their applications.
