This week, I was proud to join Mayors Against Illegal Guns—to continue the fight against gun violence and to keep our communities safe. This week marks the sixth annual National Gun Violence Survivors Week—a time when we come together to honor and amplify the stories and voices of gun violence survivors who live with the impact of gun violence every day of the year. Tragically, the United States' gun death rate is 13 times that of our peer countries.


These tragedies also hit close to home—This week marks the anniversary of the two deadly mass shootings at Half Moon bay and Monterey park in California.

During National Gun Violence Survivors Week, our city council recommits ourselves to honoring survivors with action. In the past, our city has partnered with our County in hosting anonymous gun buybacks and has also passed a safe storage and gun lock ordinance. And during our council meeting this week, we passed a <u>Proclamation Recognizing</u> National Gun Violence Survivors Week (January 22 – 26).

Pickleball Court Pilot Program

The Orange Memorial Park Master Plan envisions the addition of dedicated pickleball courts, as funding allows. To provide a space for this growing sport in the interim, tennis court #5 at Orange Memorial Park will be dedicated for pickleball activities as a demonstration project to determine if that court could be permanently used for pickleball.

Following completion of the pilot project, which will conclude in mid-2024, the court may be resurfaced to repair cracked surfacing, permanently restriped, and outfitted with pickleball nets to the extent budget allows.

Sign Hill Stewards





Affordable Connectivity Program



The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers. This Covid-era program may be ending soon, so apply soon if interested!



Student Aid & Cal. Dream Act Applications



The South San Francisco Unified School District is committed to having all of their 12th grade students complete either the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the California Dream Act Application (CADAA). In alignment with their *Drawing of a Graduate*, through this effort they are helping students LEARN, THRIVE, and NAVIGATE.

AB 469 requires all high school seniors to apply for financial aid. There are several changes to the financial aid application process this year, some of which expand aid eligibility and make it easier for families to apply, however, some of the changes compound barriers that make it challenging for historically marginalized families to complete their applications.
