
# Honoring our New Hires and Promotions in the Fire Department

### Preparing for Wildland Season




Chief Officers use a sand table simulator to fight a mock fire on Sign Hill

Asian American Pacific Islander Heritage Month is upon us, and the library has tons of fun events and activities coming up.





Help Prevent the Spread of Measles When You Travel



Before international travel: Make sure you're protected against measles. The best way to protect yourself and your loved ones from measles is by getting vaccinated. Plan to be fully vaccinated at least two weeks before you depart. If your trip is less than two weeks away and you're not protected against measles, you should still get a dose of the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine. The MMR vaccine protects against all three diseases. Contact the travel clinic in your area to make sure you get any vaccines, medications, and information you may need to stay healthy.
