# National Night Out



City of SSF Promotores Receives \$20,000 grant



The City of South San Francisco was one of only twelve jurisdictions nation-wide to receive an Advancing Economic Mobility Rapid Grant from the National League of Cities! The \$20,000 grant will assist the Promotores Program in providing expanded outreach, with a focus on Tagalog, Mandarin and Cantonese speakers. The Promotores assist individuals in accessing services with referrals to employment, housing, health care, food security, and legal aid. The program is based out of the Economic Advancement Center at 366 Grand Avenue. Office

hours are Mondays and Fridays, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Look for announcements of community meetings with the Promotores over the coming weeks and months.

# Grand Avenue Walking Tour


Explore the history and architecture of historic Grand Avenue.



Applicants will receive confirmation of their participation status by Friday, August 16, 2024. Once accepted, applicants must pay a \$50 participation fee.
