About Measure W – Business License Tax



Have you heard of the NEW BLT?

The Business License Tax (BLT) Measure updates the City's existing business tax with a progressive structure largely based on the number of employees. If approved by voters, it would result in smaller businesses paying a nominal increase and larger businesses paying a more significant increase. The measure was approved unanimously by the South San Francisco City Council on July 24, 2024, and it will appear in your November 2024 ballot as Measure W.*



*Measure W referenced here is Measure W – Business License Tax Measure, which will be on the November 2024 ballot. This is different from Measure W - a local sales tax that was approved by South San Francisco voters in November 2015.

Starting Monday, November 4, 2024, the South San Francisco Police Department has contracted LAZ Parking, a private company, to handle parking enforcement. LAZ will be the main enforcement entity, with police personnel providing support as needed.

Community Wellness and Crisis Response Team Program Evaluation

Many 911 calls handled by police officers in the United States include a mental health aspect. San Mateo County started a Community Wellness and Crisis Response Team (CWCRT) Pilot Program in December 2021 which sends a mental health clinician with a police officer to help with 911 calls related to mental health crises. South San

Francisco was fortunate to have been one of the cities to participate in the pilot program. Check out the impact report, and learn more about this important imitative here.



Staying healthy this season



It's sniffle season. Keep you and your family healthy with these tips:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover coughs and sneezes. Wearing a mask is an additional prevention strategy that you can choose to further protect yourself and others. When worn by a person with an infection, masks reduce the spread of the virus to others. Masks can also protect wearers from breathing in infectious particles from people around them.
- Get a flu vaccine.
- You can improve air quality by bringing in fresh outside air, purifying indoor air, or gathering outdoors. Cleaner air can reduce the risk of exposure to viruses.
