 —an increase of approximately 11% from the year prior.
- Tech support scams were the most widely reported kind of elder fraud in 2023.
- Investment scams were the costliest kind of elder fraud in 2023.
- Nationally and locally, victims 30 to 49 years old were the most likely group to report losses from investment fraud.
