PURPOSE:

The City's Economic Development & Housing Division (EDH) administers a housing rehabilitation voucher program that makes debris box vouchers available to qualified low-income homeowners. Vouchers are provided to remove accumulated debris and yard waste from their properties. Vouchers are used only for limited amounts of money when the usual loan process is prohibitively expensive or too time consuming. Please note that this program is only available to homeowners.

PROCEDURES if Referred by Code Enforcement:

1. Code Enforcement Safety Inspector identifies a property in need of debris removal. Code Enforcement Safety Inspector has homeowner complete and sign the Debris Box Voucher Application. Homeowner must also provide proof of income with application to validate income for all earners in the household (this includes working dependents/adult children). Acceptable documents for proof of income can be either of the following:
 - a. Copy of most recent federal income tax forms **AND** copies of last two pay stubs
 - b. Evidence of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or other income-tested government assistance
2. Code Enforcement Safety Inspector or homeowner provides EDH office with the completed Debris Box Voucher Application, proof of income, copy of code violation (if applicable), volume and type of debris, and before photos (if available) to the EDH Office.
3. EDH Office verifies that the applicant is the owner of the house.
4. EDH office approves or denies the request for a debris box and confirms the size of box to be issued.
5. If approved, EDH staff:
 - a. Conducts an environmental review to the extent necessary
 - b. Completes a voucher
 - c. Sends one (1) copy of the voucher and a list of prohibited materials to the homeowner and one (1) copy to Code Enforcement
 - d. Records name, address and voucher number in the Voucher Binder
6. Voucher Recipient (homeowner) is responsible for scheduling drop off and pick up of debris box. Instructions are on bottom half of the Voucher.
7. Should the removal of debris require any type of demolition, the homeowner is responsible for contacting the Building Division to determine if a demolition permit is required.
8. Voucher Recipient presents voucher as payment to South San Francisco Scavenger Company when the box is delivered.
9. South San Francisco Scavenger Company will submit invoice to EDH office.

PROCEDURES if Homeowner Contacts EDH Directly:

1. If homeowner calls/emails the EDH Office directly, EDH staff verifies that homeowner lives in South San Francisco. EDH staff mails or emails homeowner Debris Box Voucher Application.
2. Homeowner completes and signs the Debris Box Voucher Application. Homeowner must also provide proof of income with application to validate income for all earners in the household (this includes working dependents/adult children). Acceptable documents for proof of income can be either of the following:
 - a. Copy of most recent federal income tax forms **AND** copies of last two pay stubs
 - b. Evidence of SSI, SDI or other government assistance
3. If the homeowner meets the income requirements, EDH staff will visit the property and take photos.
4. EDH Office verifies that the applicant is the owner of the house.
5. EDH office approves or denies the request for a debris box and confirms the size of box to be issued.
6. If approved, the EDH Office:
 - a. Conducts an environmental review to the extent necessary
 - b. Completes voucher
 - c. Sends one (1) copy of voucher and a list of prohibited materials to the homeowner
 - d. Records name, address and voucher number in Voucher File
7. Voucher Recipient is responsible for scheduling drop off and pick up of debris box. Instructions are on bottom half of the Voucher.
8. Should the removal of debris require any type of demolition, the homeowner is responsible for contacting the Building Division to determine if a demolition permit is required.
9. Voucher Recipient presents voucher as payment to South San Francisco Scavenger Company when the box is delivered.



FAQs

Q. How will I be charged?

A. We charge a "per-pull rate"- each time the debris box is serviced- as well as a per-ton charge. The price is based on the size of the box.

Q. How long can I keep the debris box?

A. 3 days for a 5 yard mini box and 7 days for 14-30 cubic yard boxes.

Q. How high can I load the boxes?

A. Only up to the top. If it's overfilled, then we can't transport them. Materials should also be evenly distributed inside the box.

Q. Can anything go in the debris box?

A. No hazardous materials are allowed. (Such as oil, paint, chemicals, asbestos or any items defined as hazardous under Federal, State or local laws). Also: No tires, asbestos or electronic waste.

Q. Where do you set the box?

A. The box can be placed in the street or near your garbage enclosure. Residents requesting driveway placement will need to sign a waiver.
