Materials and supplies will be provided.

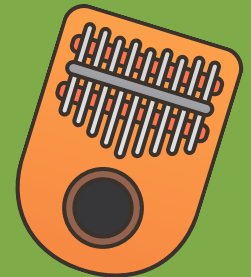


## The Kalimba King Saturday, February 17 at 2:00 PM
