Events include escape rooms, superhero training camp, make your own digital comics, and the debut of the graphic novel book club (Worst. Book Club. Ever.) discussing "Nimona" by Noelle Stevenson.

Library Requests presented by Ashley Nunes for Stacy Lein, staff liaison: Volunteer recognition - \$750.00; Comic Fest - \$400.00; and National Library Week - \$300.00. These were approved along with the transfer of \$500.00 to savings for the New Library.
