OTHER COMMENTS

The following comments were provided by meeting attendees.

General Comments

- 1. Provide more seating opportunities.
- 2. Consider adding an additional crosswalk across Spruce Avenue aligned with the northern trail head, so there will be two crosswalks instead of one.
- 3. Explore whether a soccer field could be provided.
- 4. Determine if the County facility adjacent to the park area could be utilized for public parking.
- 5. Provide supplemental lighting for the new park features.
- 6. Consider providing a restroom nearby.
- 7. Ensure the play equipment is easy to maintain.
- 8. Consult the International Mountain Bicycling Association about the design for the bike park.
- 9. Functional art could include path murals or other artistic elements that urge trail users to slow down or stay in a designated space/lane.
- 10. The flower or element that each interpretive panel is describing should be planted nearby to allow for visual learning.

Skate Plaza Comments

Overall

- 1. Consider expanding the footprint of the ramp closest to the bike park entrance and eliminate the planting area.
- 2. Provide lighting until 10 PM daily.
- 3. Lights should face the trail and skate plaza.
- 4. Consider adding benches in the planting areas.
- 5. Consider adding a drinking fountain.
- 6. Provide some shade.

View 1

- 1. Move the curved ledge next to the bank on the center platform.
- 2. Consider adding a handrail.

View 2

- 1. The ledge nearest the trail should be shorter, so one could ollie over it to grind or slide.
- 2. Ledges on the center platform should be different heights.
- 3. Put a small hubba on the edge of the stairs at the center platform.

View 3

1. Consider removing the pipe in the middle of the quarter pipe.

View 5

1. The rail in the center of the plaza could become a flat bar.

View 6

- 1. Could add pool coping on the top of the large ramp.
- 2. Angled ledge should be 90 degrees instead.
- 3. Convert A-frame ledge to a flat manual pad.
- 4. Consider filling the planting area near the trail with concrete instead of it being planting.
