



CENTENNIAL WAY TRAIL PARK SOUTH NEIGHBORHOOD NOTIFICATION TRAIL CLOSURE

DEAR RESIDENTS/BUSINESS OWNERS:

The City of South San Francisco has contracted with A&B Construction to construct the Centennial Trail Park South project between South Spruce Avenue and city limits near Huntington Avenue. The improvements create a new park along Centennial Trail to include green space, outdoor learning space, play structure and nature play space, skate area and bike track with new lighting, landscape and picnic areas. The project includes trail improvements which requires closure of the trail for safety and efficiency of construction.

**Centennial Way Trail from So. Spruce Avenue through So. Maple Ave/Huntington Ave
will be CLOSED
starting July 8th at 7:00am and will reopen July 26th at 5:00pm.**

Please use Huntington Avenue as the alternate route around the construction area while the trail is closed. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in making this project a success.
