Online Survey #2 Summary Centennial Way Trail Improvements January 6, 2023

An online survey was conducted to get feedback from the community on 35% design preferences. 78 surveys were received and below is a summary of the results.

## **CONTEXTUAL QUESTIONS**

Most people that responded to the survey live farther away from the project site and don't use the trail very often. However, a significant number of participants were within a 10-20 minute walk from the project. Many survey participants don't use the trail very often or only a few times per month.

# SPECIFIC QUESTIONS

### What features in the play area are most important to you?

- Safety is a primary concern, which can be addressed through adequate lighting, cushioned play surfacing, and possibly security camera installation.
- Climbers and swings are the most requested play features, followed by balance beams, tunnels, and slides.
- The exercise equipment should be usable by seniors.
- Plant material and trees should be provided to help make the space feel more natural and provide shade during hot days.

## How can the skate plaza be improved?

- Most participants thought the design should look like and urban plaza instead of a traditional skate park.
- A mix of open areas and skate features is desired.
- The space should provide features for different skill levels.
- Lighting and cameras are encouraged to address safety concerns.

#### How can the bike park be improved?

- Many participants think the bike park should be larger.
- There is interest to provide an area for beginner riders to practice.
- Lighting and a callbox were requested to improve safety.

#### What would you like to see represented in public art?

- Many responses indicated that the art should showcase local artists and depict local history or culture.
- Some other art themes that were commonly suggested include graffiti and nature.
