Online Threat Towards a School

On 02/06/2024 at around 10:00 P.M., the South San Francisco Police Department was made aware of an online threat directed towards Alta Loma Middle School. The threat indicated there would be a mass casualty event occurring at the school on 02/07/2024. Officers coordinated with school officials to ensure the safety and security of students, staff, and the surrounding community. Detectives vigorously investigated the case and quickly identified the suspect as a 14-year-old juvenile from Santa Clara County. The juvenile does not have any connection to South San Francisco nor the surrounding community. The juvenile was detained and through the investigation, it appears, at this time, that the threat was a hoax. Detectives are continuing to investigate to determine any applicable charges. If you have any information regarding this case, please contact the South San Francisco Police Department Criminal Investigations Bureau.
