NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Public Works Department of the City of South San Francisco, San Mateo County, California, pursuant its Open Trench Notification Process, is accepting Notices of Intent to Participate from Telecommunications Service Providers for collocating telecommunication facilities in the public right-of-way as part of the Intermountain Infrastructure Group, LLC Project located on the following Public Streets:

Intersection of Junipero Serra and Hickey Boulevard

### **Description of Work:**

Installation of HDPE Duct and Handholes from the Border of Town of Colma on Junipero Serra Boulevard and then West along Hickey Boulevard to the Border of Town of Daly City. The project will extend into both the Town of Colma and The City of Daly City. The conduits are being installed for San Mateo County, IIG, Smart Corridor. Indications of Interest are received from both Verizon and Crown Castle to participate to ensure maximum joint bore participants.

In order to participate in the above referenced project, Telecommunications Service Providers must submit the attached Notice of Intent to Participate application by (10:00am on Friday, July 26, 2019) at the office of the City of South San Francisco Engineering Division at the City Hall Annex, 315 Maple Avenue, South San Francisco, California, 94080.

Those Telecommunications Companies that submit a Notice of Intent to Participate and meet the criteria established by the City as being a competent service provider will be notified within 14 calendar days of the due date of the Notice of Intent and will be invited to participate in the project. It is the responsibility of IIG, LLC and respondents to negotiate the scope and terms of collocation work in good faith. If a respondent believes that the IIG, LLC is not negotiating in good faith, then a protest detailing the dispute may be submitted to the Public Works Department.
