



## Public Notice to Telecommunications Service Providers

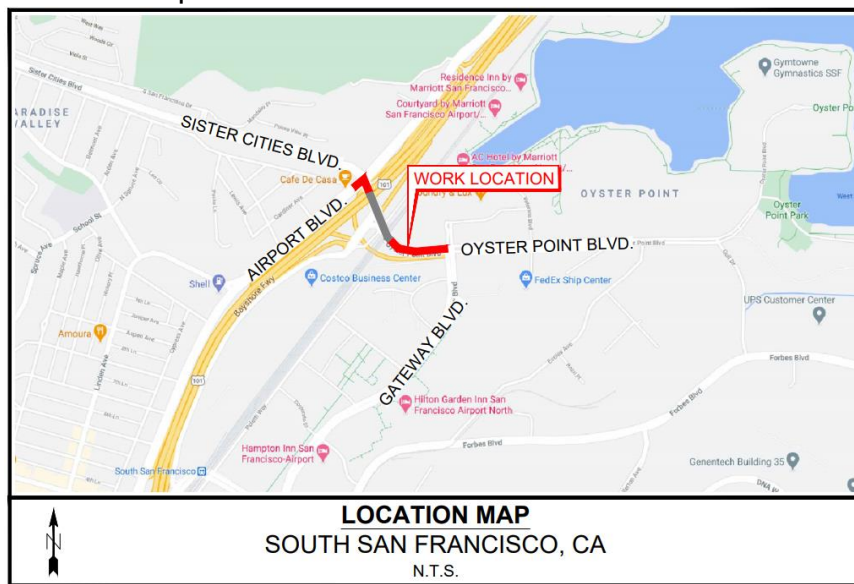
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Public Works Department of the City of South San Francisco, San Mateo County, California, pursuant its Open Trench Notification Process, is accepting Notices of Intent to Participate from Telecommunications Service Providers for collocating telecommunication facilities in the public right-of-way as part of the Intermountain Infrastructure Group Project # GTWY-BLVD\_UG-01\_SSF located on the following Public Streets:

Along Airport Boulevard and Oyster Point Boulevard from southwest of Sister Cities Boulevard to Gateway Boulevard

### Description of Work:

This project proposes a new underground construction of approximate 824 feet via directional boring and trenching along Airport Boulevard and Oyster Point Boulevard.

In order to participate in the above referenced project, Telecommunications Service Providers must submit the attached Notice of Intent to Participate application by (10:00am on Friday, July 30, 2021) at the office of the City of South San Francisco Engineering Division at the City Hall Annex, 315 Maple Avenue, South San Francisco, California, 94080.

Those Telecommunications Companies that submit a Notice of Intent to Participate and meet the criteria established by the City as being a competent service provider will be notified within 14 calendar days of the due date of the Notice of Intent and will be invited to participate in the project. It is the responsibility of Intermountain Infrastructure Group and respondents to negotiate the scope and terms of collocation work in good faith. If a respondent believes that Intermountain Infrastructure Group is not negotiating in good faith, then a protest detailing the dispute may be submitted to the Public Works Department.

# Notice of Intent to Participate

This Notice of Intent to Participate is submitted in response to the Public Notice to Telecommunications Service Providers dated June 25, 2021 issued by the City of South San Francisco Public Works Department for collocating telecommunication facilities in the public right-of-way as part of the Intermountain Infrastructure Group Project # GTWY-BLVD\_UG-01\_SSF located on the following Public Streets:
